1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of the concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case Complaint No.248/2018 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 pending in the Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ratia.

Order dated 16.02.2024

“None for petitioner.

As per office report, notice to respondent No.2 could not be issued as process fee has not been filed.

Case has been called, however, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 15.03.2024.

On filing of process fee, let notice to respondent No.2 be issued for the date fixed.”

Order dated 15.03.2024

“None for petitioner.

As per the report of Registry, process fee has not been filed.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

On filing of process fee, let notice be issued to respondent No.2 for 03.05.2024.”

Order dated 03.05.2024

“None for petitioner.

As per office report, notice to respondent No.2 could not be issued as process fee has not been filed.

Case has been called, however, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.



In the interest of justice, adjourned to 26.07.2024.

In case the petitioner files the process fee, let notice to the said respondent be issued for 26.07.2024.”

3. In the circumstances, this Court is satisfied that neither the petitioner nor his counsel is interested in pursuing the instant petition, which accordingly stands dismissed for non prosecution.
