NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to hear and decide the statutory departmental revision petition dated 19.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) along with application for stay dated 19.09.2024 (Annexures P-6) filed by the petitioner against the order dated 16.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.1, being Appellate Authority and order dated 19.07.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3, being Punishing Authority, in a time bound manner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for deciding the revision petition dated 19.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) along with application for stay dated 19.09.2024 (Annexures P-6) filed by the



petitioner expeditiously by passing a speaking order in a time-bound manner. He further prays that till the final disposal of the said revision petition, no recovery be made from the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Sh. Rajesh Sehgal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the prayer made in the present writ petition.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

6. Respondent No.2-Revisional Authority is directed to decide the revision petition dated 19.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) along with application for stay dated 19.09.2024 (Annexures P-6) filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Since the statutory revision petition filed by the petitioner is pending and yet to be decided, it will be in the interest of justice that no further recovery be effected from the petitioner.

8. The present petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
