The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in cross case bearing G.D. No.28 dated 27.09.2023 under Sections 326, 324, 341, 427, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC in FIR No.132 dated 27.09.2023 under Sections 326, 324, 341, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot (offence under Section 326 IPC added later on).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 02.11.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

A short reply dated 06.01.2024 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Om Parkash

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submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 02.11.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 02.11.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
