Mr. Karan Singh Sura, Advocate appeared on behalf of respondent no.1 and filed his Vakalatnama. The same is taken on record.

1. None has come present on behalf of the appellant. Even on the last date of hearing, no one was present on behalf of the appellant. The present appeal is barred by limitation of delay of 467 days that has occurred in filing the present appeal.

2. Challenge in the present appeal is to the order dated 05.07.2018, passed by learned Single Judge in CWP-16072-2018, whereby appointment of respondent no.1-Hukam Chand as Lambardar of village Nariyala, Tehsil Ballabgarh, District Faridabad, was upheld by dismissing the writ petition filed by the present appellant. The appointment was made way back in the year 2012. Neither the Commissioner nor the Financial

Commissioner chose to interfere with the order dated 13.03.2012 (Annexure P-3), passed by the Collector. Thus, the learned Single Judge dismissed the writ petition while noticing that there was an inordinate delay of almost four years in approaching the High Court after finalization of the proceedings upto the Financial Commissioner, dated 25.08.2014 (Annexure P-6).

3. Under such circumstances, we have no hesitation in dismissing the application seeking condonation of delay as well as the main appeal itself. Resultantly, both the application seeking condonation of delay as well as the main appeal, are dismissed.
