The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Article 227 of Constitution of Indian with a prayer to grant extension of time and permission to deposit the 20% of the compensation/cheque amount as ordered by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur in Criminal Appeal bearing No.CRA-185-2023 instituted on 04.08.2023 titled as Maninderjit Singh Vs State Bank of India vide order dated 04.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) (arising out of complaint No.MACT/269/2018).

At the outset, learned for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the impugned order dated 04.08.2023, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, the petitioner shall deposit the amount of 20% of compensation within a period of four weeks from today.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent has no serious objections to the said prayer.

In view of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the petitioner is permitted to deposit the 20% of the amount of

compensation, in terms of the impugned order dated 04.08.2023, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, within 04 weeks from today.

It is, however, made clear that no further extension of time shall be granted.

The present petition stands disposed off.
