NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent Board to consider and promote the petitioner on the post of Executive Enginner (Civil).

2. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 has produced a copy of order dated 11.10.2024, whereby the petitioner has been promoted to the Post of Executive Engineer w.e.f. 09.12.2022, when Sh. Dharvinder Kumar-respondent No.4 was promoted.

3. He submits that in view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous. However, learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that since the petitioner has been given notional promotion and has not been granted the pay of the promoted post, therefore, he may be given liberty to make a representation for redressal of his grievance to the respondent-

Department.

4. If any such representation is submitted by the petitioner within two weeks, the same shall be considered and disposed of by the competent authority, within a period of 03 weeks from the date of receipt of the same.

5. In this view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous and with aforesaid liberty.
