Upon advance notice, Mr. Saurav Verma, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 & 3-Punjab National Bank, who, on instructions, submits that the recoveries, if any shall be returned / reimbursed to the petitioner by 15.11.2024 and no further recovery shall be effected.

[2] In view of the aforesaid stand / undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
