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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, seeking directions to respondent No. 1 (Principal Secretary-cum-Financial Commissioner, Revenue and Disaster Management) to conclude the proceedings in the revision petition (ROR-758/2018-19), filed by the petitioner.

2. In pursuance to advance copy of the instant civil writ petition having been served upon State of Haryana, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG Haryana appears and on instructions from Mr. Karambeer, Assistant in the office of respondent No. 1, submits that the aforesaid revision petition (ROR-758/2018-19) is pending consideration before learned Financial Commissioner for 21.11.2024. It is also informed that the case is at the initial stage and the same would require some time for conclusion. Be that as it may, she submits that in any case, the case shall be finally decided within one year from the next date fixed before learned Financial Commissioner.

3. In view of aforesaid submission made by learned State counsel, the instant civil writ petition is disposed of with a direction to learned Financial Commissioner (respondent No. 1) to decide the revision petition (ROR-758/2018-19), filed by the petitioner, preferably within a period of one year from the date fixed before it i.e. 21.11.2024.

4. Disposed of accordingly.

5. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
