RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the orders dated 16.08.2022 and 27.10.2022 passed in CWP-4725-2022 and the undertaking given through counsel on 27.10.2022.
2. It is not even disputed by the counsel for the petitioner that the alternate plot has since been allotted to the petitioner.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
4. Dismissed.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same before the Court where the above-stated writ petition is stated to be still pending.
