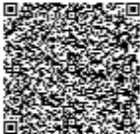

JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. At the outset, Mr. Padamkant Dwivedi, learned counsel for respondents No.2 & 3 stated that all the retiral benefits have been paid to the petitioner along with interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that so far as the grant of retiral benefits along with interest is concerned, he is satisfied with the same because the petitioner has received the same. He submitted that however the benefit of revision of pay-scale has not been given to the petitioner and he may be permitted to file a separate representation to the respondents with regard to the same and a direction may be issued to the respondents that in case such a representation is filed, then the same will be considered and decided by the respondents in accordance with law in a time bound manner. He further submitted that since the relief sought in the present petition has been granted to the petitioner, the present petition may be



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disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

4. In the event of the petitioner filing any such representation to the respondents for grant of benefit of revision of pay-scale, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents in accordance with law within a period of four months thereafter.
