

compromised the matter during the pendency of the appeal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks quashing of the FIR (*supra*) as well as the impugned judgment and order of conviction dated 05.08.2024. He further relies upon the judgments of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in ‘*Kapil Gupta Vs. State of NCT of Delhi and others*’ 2022 (4) RCR (Criminal) 497 & ‘*Ramgopal Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh, LL 2022 SC Page 516*’ and the judgment of this Court passed in ‘*Karan Sharma Vs. State of Haryana and another*’ CRM-M-30033 of 2020 (O&M) decided on 22.12.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file appropriate application in the appeal filed by the petitioner i.e. CRA-S-3013-2024 for the relief claimed in the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
