1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and also direct the respondents No.4 to 12 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.
2. Notice of motion was issued and in response thereto, reply has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the matter was referred to the Medication and Conciliation Centre of this Court but the effective mediation could not be conducted and the matter was sent back to this Court.
3. Now, the applicants-petitioners have filed the present application bearing CRM-W-1799-2023 with a prayer to dispose off the

main petition in view of the statements given by the private respondents as appended with the main petition as Annexures R-1 to R-11 respectively and in view of the grounds mentioned in the application.

4. Notice of the application.
5. On the asking of Court, [Mr. Karan Garg, AAG, Haryana](#) accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3-State and submits that he has no objection if the present application is accepted.
6. Heard.
7. From the perusal of the case file, it is made out that the private respondents No.4 to 12 have stated in their statements that they will not cause any harm to the petitioners and thus, the present petition has become infructuous.
8. In view of the prayer made in the present application, the same is allowed and accordingly, the main petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
9. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
