[1] Status report by way of affidavit dated 08.01.2024 of Shri Kaptan Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh, on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed in Court today.
The same is taken on record.

[2] On 02.11.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Present: Mr. Munfaid Khan, Advocate for the petitioner.

Present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.177, dated 21.09.2023, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he tried to get his vehicle released on Superdari on the basis of a fake R.C.

As per contention of learned counsel for the petitioner, the original R.C. was lost. The copy was supplied to him by an agent.

A perusal of the paper book reveals that the petitioner was allowed interim anticipatory bail by the Court by learned Sessions Judge, Nuh. However, petitioner failed to provide the details of the agent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner requests to provide one opportunity to the petitioner to co-operate in the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Adjourned to 11.01.2024 for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal / surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

[3] Today, learned State counsel on instructions from SI Dashrath, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 02.11.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[4] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 02.11.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
