Served with the advance copy of the petition, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent(s) submits that per the policy, the Letter of Intent (LOI) is issued to the successful bidder only through an online platform. And, the LOI for allotment of Shop Plot No.92, Market Committee, Ismailabad, was issued to the petitioner on February 4, 2024. However, for the petitioner, in terms of clause 5, failed to deposit 75% of the premium/consideration within the stipulated period, the said LOI ceased to exist. He has shared with us a copy of the Letter of Intent, dated February 4, 2024, which is taken on record as **Mark 'X'**.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to file afresh, with better particulars and necessary documents.

As prayed, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty prayed for.
