The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS in a case bearing FIR No.10 dated 26.01.2024 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 21.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel has filed a short reply dated 18.11.2024 which is taken on record. He, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 21.10.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the above, the interim order dated 21.10.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
