[1] On 02.11.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Present: Mr. J.K. Singla, Advocate for the petitioners.

The two petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.174 dated 13.10.2023 registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Act No.45 of 1860) at Police Station City 1 Mansa, District Mansa.

As per prosecution allegations, on 12.10.2023, complainant Kiranjeet Kaur was assaulted by the petitioners and others. Attribution to the petitioner Sarbjeet Kaur is that she had caught hold of the complainant from her hair, whereas petitioner Gugni @ Bahadur along with Dilshad Ali and other persons gave her fist and kick blows.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners have been falsely implicated since they used to stop the complainant from selling intoxicant substance in the area. It is further submitted that main accused to whom injuries are attributed are already in custody. Learned counsel submits that petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. P.S. Pandher, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State. Copy of the petition be supplied to him during course of the day.

Adjourned to 09.01.2024 for filing status report.

In the meantime, in case of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. They shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade them from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. They shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

[2] Today, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Modan Singh, has informed this Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 02.11.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[3] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 02.11.2023, whereby the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, they shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
