This is an application under Section 151 CPC for advancing the date of hearing of the main petition from 17.12.2024 to an early date.

Notice of the application to learned counsel for the non-applicant/appellant.

Mr. Vishal Aggarwal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicant/appellant and raises no objection to the revision petition being heard on an early date.

Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the intent for advancing the date of hearing of the main case is that the contesting respondent Nos.1 to 3 (claimants) are being prejudiced due to the pendency of the present petition, as the proceedings before the MACT have virtually been stalled. It is further submitted that respondent Nos.1 to 3 do not want to contest the instant revision petition subject to their right to lead rebuttal

Learned counsel for the petitioner concedes to the aforesaid submission.

Accordingly, hearing of the main petition is advanced from 17.12.2024 to today and with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, same is taken on board.

- 1. In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties, as noticed hereinabove, the present revision petition is allowed and the impugned order dated 23.10.2023 is set aside. Accordingly, the petitioner is afforded one effective opportunity to adduce additional evidence and contesting respondent Nos.1 to 3 (claimants) shall have a right to lead their evidence to rebut the additional evidence that may be brought on record.
