In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner applied for the post of District Programme Manager as advertised vide Advertisement dated 08.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) but the petitioner is not being called for interview for the reasons best known to the respondents though the petitioner is eligible.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-7) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Charan Preet Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Anil Sharma, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the legal notice dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-7) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
