1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take action against respondent No. 4 in terms of his representation dated 18.09.2024 (*Annexure P-1*).
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed the representation on 18.09.2024 (*Annexure P-1*) before respondents No. 2 and 3 raising his grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would feel satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondents No. 2 and 3 to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and take necessary action, if so required.
