The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.51 dated 23.07.2024, under Section 420 of IPC and under Section 13 of the Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from S.I. Gurminder Singh also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 19.11.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 18.10.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner

shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
