1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the official respondents to take appropriate action on the complaints (Annexure P-2 to P-4), which are stated to have been filed by the husband of the petitioner.
2. Learned State counsel submits that certain complaints were received from the present petitioner, however, after holding the inquiry, no substance was found in the complaints and the complaints have been ordered to be filed. She has further assured the court that the petitioner and her family members shall be protected and in case any application is received with regard to the threat to their lives and liberty, proper legal action shall be taken promptly.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction is required.
4. Needless to observe that the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail her civil as well as criminal remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
