RAJESH BHARDWAJ J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing and setting aside the Summons dated 18.10.2023 bearing No.D-501/SDPO/North/East, U.T., Chandigarh and Summon bearing No.D-502/SDPO/North/East, U.T. Chandigarh dated 18.10.2023, issued to the petitioners, by the Office of the Sub Divisional Police, North-East U.T. Chandigarh in reference to complaint dated 11.10.2023 vide ICMS/2023/026440, being beyond jurisdiction of U.T. Police as the arrayed petitioners are residents of New Delhi and Saharanpur, U.P. and the petitioner No.1 is holding the office of Director, in Pinacle Kisan Products Ltd., a company with its Registered office also in Saharanpur, U.P. and as such being contrary to Section 160 Cr.P.C. and the ratio of law



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as laid down by the Hon’ble Delhi High Court in case of ‘**Ravinder Singh V. State and another W.P. (Crl.) No.971/2010**’.

2. The Court issued notice in the present case on 03.11.2023. However, during the pendency of the present petition, FIR bearing FIR No.30, dated 18.04.2024, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station IT Park, District Chandigarh has been registered against the petitioners and the same is under investigation.

3. This Court has already dismissed the quashing petition filed by the petitioners vide order dated 14.08.2024 passed in CRM-M-39029-2024.

4. Thus, in view of the attending facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to pursue their alternative remedies as available to them in accordance with law.
