1. On 06.12.2023, the following order was passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in:-

FIR	Dated	Police Station	Sections
80	27.06.2023	Kartarpur, District Jalandhar	420, 494, 511, 120-B of IPC

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is mother of the main accused Jasmeet Pal. He submits that petitioner’s son was to marry Poonam Bhatti and her family was aware of the marital status of her son. He placed reliance upon the affidavit of Poonam Bhatti respondent No.3 wherein she has deposed in her favour.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. A.P.S. Tung, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. List on 09.01.2024. 6. Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 21.12.2023 at 10:00 A.M. at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (Rural), and join the investigation and appear as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, she shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating

Officer. She shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Lakhwinderjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in pursuance to the aforesaid order, and she has fully co-operated with the investigation process, and she is no more required for any further custodial investigation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed, and order dated 06.12.2023 is, hereby, made absolute.
