1. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that petitioner was attacked by respondents No.6 to 9 on 29.06.2024 and on the same very day, the petitioner was medico legally examined and copy of her MLR is Annexure P-2. That on the very next day i.e. 30.06.2024, the petitioner reported the matter to the police vide complaint Annexure P-5 along with copy of her MLR but the police failed to take any action and on this petitioner gave another complaint Annexure P-6 dated 27.08.2024 against the culprits but police authorities did not take any action. Being aggrieved the petitioner has filed the present petition seeking direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide complaints Annexure P-5 and P-6 supported by MLR, in a given time frame in accordance with law.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. P.K. Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that as per his instructions one FIR has been registered against the present petitioner. He further submits that in case any



such complaints lodged by petitioner are pending the same will be looked and decided by the competent authority as per law, at the earliest.

4. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide complaint Annexure P-5 dated 30.06.2024 and Annexure P-6 dated 27.08.2024 in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
