1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the complaint dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) for registration of FIR against the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but his grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur-respondent No.3 by way of complaint dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-4), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that

the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur-respondent No.3 to depute a senior officer to look into the complaint dated 17.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
