1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 06.09.2023 passed in CWP-19743-2023.

2. Compliance affidavit on behalf of respondent filed in the Registry is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
