The petitioner, by way of present revision petition, seeks setting aside of the order dated 22.08.2023 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh, whereby the compliant under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C., filed at the instance of petitioner, was dismissed.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to assail the impugned order before the Revisional Court alongwith an application seeking condonation of delay.

[3] Permitted to do so.

[4] **Dismissed as withdrawn** with the liberty, as prayed for.

[5] It is made clear that in case the revision is filed before the District & Sessions Judge concerned within a period of two weeks from today, the period of pendency of present revision petition may be considered sympathetically towards condonation of delay.
