KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The present appeal has been filed by the appellants under Section 14A of the SC and ST Act against the order dated 21.10.2023 passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani whereby the application filed by the appellants under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in criminal case having FIR No.545 dated 04.09.2023, Police Station Sadar Bhiwani, was dismissed.
2. On the last date of hearing, the appellants were granted interim bail and were directed to join the investigation with the police.
3. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the appellants submits

that by virtue of the aforesaid order of interim bail, appellants have joined the investigation with the police. It is further submitted that even otherwise, the matter stands compromised between the parties.

4. The State counsel on instructions from DSP Ramesh Kumar submits that indeed the appellants have joined the investigation with the police and are not required for any further investigation by the police.

5. Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant while endorsing the assertions made by counsel for the appellants further submits that matter stands compromised between the parties and the complainant is having no objection if the present appeal is allowed.

6. In light of the above, without expressing on the merits of the case, the present appeal is allowed and order of interim bail dated 22.11.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute and the appellants are to abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
