HARKESH MANUJA, J.(Oral)

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents on instructions from Mr. Sunil, Legal Assistant submits that the arrears of pay scale for a period of 38 months prior to the filing of the writ petition shall be released in favour of the petitioners in pursuance to the order passed in LPA-2132-2024 within a period of two weeks from today.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Rule discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
