This is an application under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 for placing on record notice of accusation dated 05.06.2024 (Annexure P-5)

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and the accompanied document (Annexure P-5) is taken on record.

Main case.

1. Petitioner Manju Sanga filed petition under Section 528 BNSS praying for quashing criminal complaint No.NACT/1/21 dated 04.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and summoning order dated 10.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bhiwani vide which petitioner has been summoned and all subsequent proceedings arisen therefrom.
2. Today learned counsel for petitioner has also placed on record copy of notice of accusation served upon the petitioner/accused on 05.06.2024 under the provisions of 138 of NI Act.

3. In light of aforesaid factual position, it is clear that when present petition was filed by petitioner on 23.09.2024 notice of accusation was already served upon him on 05.06.2024 and the same has not been specifically challenged by petitioner. Therefore, petition filed by petitioner, at this stage, is not maintainable and the same is accordingly disposed of while granting liberty to the petitioner that he can avail appropriate legal remedy available to him to challenge the said notice of accusation served upon him in the aforesaid complaint.

4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
