1. On 28.11.2019, Co-ordinate Bench of this Court has ordered to pay an amount of Rs.30,000/- to respondent No.2-workman within a period of one week. The said direction has not been complied with in letter and spirit. Even, Mr. Rahul Makkar, Advocate, who represents the petitioners is not present to inform the Court.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. 13.12.2022, none appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

Therefore, this Court is unable to proceed further for the purpose of hearing of the petition. Thus, the present petition is dismissed in default.

2. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application for seeking revival of the present writ petition with the preparation to argue the matter within eight weeks from today, in case any substantive issue still exists alongwith a cause of action to the petitioner.
