1. The present Criminal Revision Petition has been filed for setting aside the impugned order dated 07.08.2023, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Fast Track Special Court, Bhiwani, whereby an application moved by the petitioner under Section 319 Cr.P.C., in case FIR No. 22, dated 10.02.2023, under Sections 376 (2) (n), 450 & 506 of the IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Sation Behal, was dismissed.
2. A status report, dated 03.02.2024, by way of an affidavit of Sh. Ashok Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Loharu, Bhiwani, has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel. The same is taken on record.
3. In the said report, it is alleged that the trial has been concluded in the aforesaid FIR and the present petitioner has been acquitted by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani, vide its order dated 20.01.2024 and therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
