1. Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the election process conducted for village Sarustigarh, P.O. Behru, Tehsil & District, Patiala which was done without issuing any notification for delimitation for the Gram Panchayat Elections.
2. It is not disputed that the election has already been held on 15.10.2024 and the writ petition was filed on 15.10.2024 itself. The disputed issues have been raised regarding the fact that the ward of one of the petitioners has been changed from one ward to another. The remedy as such lies before the statutory authorities being the Punjab State Election Commissioner to take action on the representation.

3. In such circumstances, we are of the considered opinion that the present writ petition is not maintainable under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India and is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
