1. This application has been filed for impleading Priya Verma (accused) as respondent No.4 in the main case.
2. The application is allowed as prayed for. Priya Verma is impleaded as respondent No.4 in the main case. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

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This petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India has been filed seeking direction to the official respondent(s) to protect the life & liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent No.4 and take action on her representation dated 05.10.2024 (Annexure P1).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 05.10.2024 (Annexure P1) before respondent No.2 raising her grievances as mentioned

He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereupon.

- 4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Vinay Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 05.10.2024 (Annexure P1) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
- 6. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect their life and liberty.
