1. Deen Mohamad has filed anticipatory bail in FIR No.53 dated 27.09.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Block Majri, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).
2. Earlier vide order dated 03.11.2023 present petitioner was granted interim bail, relevant part of which runs as under:-

“In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of arrest of the petitioner,



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he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Petitioner was also directed to bring demand draft of Rs.65,14,000/- on the next date of hearing.

3. Notice was given. Mr. Manbir Singh Bath, Advocate appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 whereas learned counsel representing State filed status report.

4. Today, learned counsel representing respondent No.2 confirmed that matter has been compromised between the parties. Copy of Memorandum of Settlement is also placed on record. Learned counsel representing State further confirmed that present petitioner has joined the investigation. Therefore, no purpose would be served by sending petitioner behind the bars.

5. Since the matter has been compromised, therefore, interim bail already granted to petitioner-Deen Mohamad vide order dated 03.11.2023 stands confirmed subject to the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition is accordingly allowed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
