1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that only the provisional pension has been released and not regular pension hence, the respondents be directed to release the regular pension of the petitioner along with other benefits which have been withheld.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the disciplinary proceedings which have not attained finality and only the payments which can be withheld as per 2016 Rules, withheld and immediately upon the conclusion of the departmental proceedings, whatever amount the petitioner is found entitled for, will be released within a period of six months of the conclusion of the said departmental proceedings and the departmental proceedings will be concluded within a period of three months from today.



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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, no further order is required to be passed and the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
