1. On 13.9.2023, a co-ordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following:-

“By the impugned order dated 20.02.2015, petitioners were declared as proclaimed persons. Instant petition was instituted in the year 2018 and notice of motion was issued on 11.12.2018 and the matter is pending since then. By order dated 24.08.2023, this Court ordered the listing of the petition in the urgent cause list.

Learned APP, U.T., Chandigarh has placed on record, a copy of order dated 18.12.2014 passed by this Court, whereby petition preferred by the petitioners seeking quashing of the FIR, Annexure P1 has been rejected. He further submits that prayer of the petitioners for being released on bail has been rejected upto the Apex Court. Copy of the order has been placed on record. He asserts that as the petitioners have evaded the process of law, they should be directed to surrender.

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On request made on behalf of arguing
counsel for the petitioners, adjourned to 08.12.2023.”

2. However, thereafter, the learned counsel for the petitioners
did not cause appearance and despite intimation to the learned counsel for
the petitioners, today no one has caused appearance on behalf of the
petitioners.

3. Therefore, the instant petition is, hereby, dismissed for want
of prosecution.
