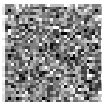

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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (Oral)

1. The grievance of the petitioners is that their proposal for grant of sanction to construct residential houses in Village Nada and Karoran, District Mohali, Punjab, which are situated close to the Sukhna Wildlife Sanctuary, are not being processed by the concerned authorities.

2. Learned counsel for State of Punjab has drawn the attention of this Court to recent interlocutory order passed by Apex Court on 14.02.2024 in Writ Petition(s) (Civil) No.202 of 1995, titled as IN RE: T.N. Godavarman Thirumulpad Vs. Union of India and others, whereby, I.A. No.263809 & 263810 of 2023, raising similar prayers as raised in this petition were kept



pending and are under consideration, since, the Apex Court appears to be seized of the matter.

3. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to approach the Apex Court.
