The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the order dated 25.09.2024 (Annexure P-7) passed by the learned Commissioner, Faridabad Division, Faridabad.

2. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, appears on behalf of the respondents/State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been served upon the State. She, on instructions from Mr. Mukesh Kumar, Deputy Superintendent to Divisional Commissioner refers to Annexure P-7 and submits that stay application filed by the petitioner along with the appeal, challenging the order dated 23.08.2024 (Annexure P-4), whereby the petitioner was removed from the post of Sarpanch; is pending before the learned Divisional Commissioner, Faridabad for 30.10.2024 and in all probabilities, the stay application filed

by the petitioner along with his appeal, would be considered and decided on the said date, i.e. 30.10.2024.

In view of the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the learned Divisional Commissioner, Faridabad to consider and decide the stay application filed by the petitioner along with his appeal, positively on the date fixed, i.e. 30.10.2024 and not in any case beyond three weeks thereafter.
