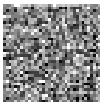

1. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner today.
2. The present writ petition has been filed challenging the advertisement (Annexure P-2).
3. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submitted that the present writ petition has become infructuous in view of the fact that the aforesaid impugned advertisement (Annexure P-2) has already been withdrawn and the respondent-University has decided to re-advertise the posts and apart from the above, even otherwise also the respondent-University has decided to extend the benefit of 5% relaxation to the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)/Differently abled and other classes.



4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed.
5. However, in case any cause of action still survives, then the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of the present writ petition.
