accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
