1. The present is a second petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.014 dated 01.02.2021, under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.
2. At the outset, Mr. Rohit Ahuja, learned DAG, Punjab while referring to the affidavit filed by the DSP, Sub Division City, District Hoshiarpur submitted that at the time when the affidavit was filed by the DSP only one witness was remaining i.e. Gurdeep Singh and since the aforesaid witness has left the country, he has already been given up.
