1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 27.06.2023 (Annexure P-3) and promotion order dated 20.02.2023 (Annexure P-4).
2. The petitioner claims that he was promoted as ASI w.e.f. 25.02.2009. The petitioner passed Upper School Course on 19.07.2022, however, in the list of Sub Inspectors, the name of the petitioner is missing.
3. Mr. Surender Pal, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance of the petitioner, at this stage would be redressed, if respondents are directed to decide his legal notice dated 17.07.2023 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.
4. Notice of motion.

Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service.

With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.

Learned State counsel submits that as per their record no junior of the petitioner has been promoted, nevertheless, Competent Authority would look into the grievance of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order on the representation/legal notice of the petitioner.

In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents/Competent Authority to decide representation/legal notice of the petitioner within 3 months from today.
