The prayer in the petition under Section 439 Cr.PC is for grant of concession of interim regular bail for 14 days to the petitioner on the ground of marriage of his nephew (Bhanja) in FIR No.91 dated 02.09.2022 at P.S. Bahavwala, District Fazilka under Section 302 IPC.

The Counsel for the applicant contends that the marriage of his nephew (Bhanja) is to be solemnized with Rupali daughter of Sh. Krishan Ji Rohila on 06.11.2024. He contends that he be granted interim bail for the said purpose for a period of 14 days.

The Counsel for the State submits that the Sessions Court, Fazilka vide its order dated 03.10.2024 allowed the petitioner to attend the marriage in custody on 06.11.2024 from 8.00 am to 5.00 pm. The State Counsel further, states that the petitioner be not granted the concession of bail but be sent in custody itself.



I have heard learned Counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the allegations levelled against the petitioner I do not deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of interim bail for 14 days.

However, as the marriage of his nephew is to take place on 06.11.2024, the Jail Superintendent concerned is directed to send the petitioner-Rakesh Kumar @ Raka son of Sh. Vijay Pal Singh in custody to the venue where the marriage ceremony of his nephew is to take place on 06.11.2024 between 8.00 am to 8.00 am on 07.11.2024. The expenses incurred for the aforesaid purpose shall be borne by the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of.
