The petitioners in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seek quashing of the notification dated 10.01.2011 (Annexure P-3) issued under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 and notices dated 08.06.2020 (Annexures P-7 to P-14), on the basis of the judgment of the Full Bench of this Court passed in **Deepak Aggarwal & others Vs. State of Haryana & others, 2008(1) RCR (Civil) 161**. The writ petition was filed in October, 2023.

2. It has been brought to our notice that the said judgment already stood reversed by the Apex Court in **HSIIDC & others Vs. Deepak Aggarwal & others, 2022(3) RCR (Civil) 934**, which was prior to filing of the present petition.

- 3. Faced with this situation, counsel is not in a position to press the present writ petition.
- 4. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
