The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0377 dated 28.05.2023 registered under Sections 34, 436 and 506 IPC at Police Station Chandni Bagh, District Panipat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.11.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 23.01.2024 by way of an affidavit of Narneder Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Panipat has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.11.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
