1. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that earlier respondent No.5 joined hands with the petitioner to run the production house of the petitioner and while doing so, respondent No.5 took amount of Rs.8 lacs approximately from the petitioner on one pretext or the other but thereafter, failed to return the said amount and when the petitioner asked about his money, respondent No.5 through respondent No.4 started extending threats to the petitioner. On this, number of representations were given by the petitioner to respondent no.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action. The copies of the concerned representations are Annexures P-3 to P-7. Being aggrieved, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS 2023 with prayer that necessary direction be given to the police authorities to consider and decide his aforesaid representations in accordance with law at the earliest.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of

the State and submits that one FIR was registered against the present petitioner on the complaint of respondent No.5. He further submits that in case any such representations submitted by the petitioner are pending, the same will be looked into and decided by the competent authority as per law in a given time frame.

4. In rebuttal, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that aforesaid FIR, which was registered on the basis of false allegations made by respondent No.5 was investigated and police has prepared cancellation report but due to pressure of respondents No.4 and 5, the same is not presented till date in any Court.

5. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representations Annexure P-3 to P-7 in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
