1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.5 and 6, who are threatening the petitioner to hand over the custody of the minor children.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the petitioner's husband was murdered, by some unknown persons, she along with her children are being continuously threatened by her parents in law i.e. the private respondents and are being threatened with dire consequences in case she does not hand over the custody of her two minor children to them.

3. On a pointed query put to the learned counsel as to whether any litigation is pending between the parties, he has categorically replied in the negative. Learned counsel has further submitted that a

representation dated 07.10.2024 (Annexure P/3) has been emailed to respondent No.1, however, till date the official respondents had not come to the rescue of the petitioner and her children. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to look into the representation dated 07.10.2024 (Annexure P/3) at the earliest and take appropriate steps as may be required under the law so that her life and liberty may not be jeopardized.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Rana, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with directions to to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to look into the representation dated 07.10.2024 (Annexure P/3) and take necessary steps at the earliest, if any required, in accordance with law.
