Through the instant second petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, prayer is made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.54 dated 18.3.2024, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and under Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983, registered at Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner in the asking for the relief (supra) submits that there are change of circumstances i.e. a compromise has been effected between the parties and complainant, who is the author of the instant complaint, whereas, it is already recorded in the earlier order declining

the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner that there are number of complaints pending investigation in the instant FIR, the present petitioner has also duped other persons, therefore, the compromise effected with the author of the complaint is of no significance.

3. In view of the above, the instant petition is, hereby, **dismissed**.
