[1] Reply by way of affidavit dated 18.01.2024 of Shri Achhru Ram Sharma, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Jalalabad, on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed in Court today.
The same is taken on record.

[2] On 06.11.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Present: Mr. Parvesh Sachdeva, Advocate for the petitioner.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.97 dated 27.09.2023 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 336, 148, 149, 427 of the IPC & Section 25/27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Arniwala Sheikh Subhan, District Fazilka.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that compromise has already been effected amongst the parties. Copy of which is Annexure P-2.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randeep Singh Khaira, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1- State.

Mr. Naveen Kumar, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2, and filed his power of attorney.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 concedes the factum of compromise.

Adjourned to 18.01.2024 for filing status report by respondent No.1- State.

In the meantime, in case of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. However, it is directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

[3] Today, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 06.11.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[4] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 06.11.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
